This Month's Focus

This month our class will be focusing on harvest, making soup for our families and the meaning of being thankful. We will learn about the life cycle of the different vegetables in our soup. We will be discussing how to read a recipe, and the different measurements that are needed of each ingredient.

We will also be brainstorming what it means to be thankful and what each of us are thankful for!

We are talking about brown and the different shades it has, the numbers 2 & 3 the triangle shape.

Below are some of the activities the children will be doing this month!

Math:

The children will make a hands-on graph using the different ingredients they bring in to see what ingredients we have the most, least and what we need more of. We will also be using measuring tools to make our soup!

We will continue working on patterns, number recognition and counting the days of the month.

Science:

As we work on our soup we will be discussing solid vs liquid. We will also investigate the life cycle of vegetables we are using,

Literacy & Writing:

The children will continue writing in their journals daily. We will be learning how to read and use recipes as we prepare for our special family day. The children will also be writing their one recipe cards for something they love to eat.

The children love the Wonders curriculum letter cards and we will continue to use them daily!

Passport Stamps:

The local fire department will be coming to our classroom. The children will get to explore a fire truck, learn about fire safety and being a firefighter.
